### ESOP Fall Curriculum Proposal

### Education Enterprise Sub-Committee

### 22 JULY 2020

<u>Preamble:</u> This document is a proposal from the Education Enterprise Sub-Committee on returning to campus for the PharmD, PhD, and MS programs for the Fall 2020 semester. It does not include details around experiential education for the PharmD program or specifics for students in research laboratories. Changes to this proposal will be approved by the Operational Return Committee and disseminated to the School.

All students, faculty, and staff are expected to review the <u>Carolina Together</u> website and adhere to the <u>Community Standards</u> outlined by UNC. Information in this document is in alignment with information on the University's Carolina Together website and adheres to state and local guidelines.

#### **Guiding Principles**

- The University desires to have <u>students on campus in a hybrid learning environment</u>, realizing students will not always be able to attend in person.
- <u>Safety</u> of students, staff, and faculty is first and foremost.
- <u>Social distancing of 6 feet with surgical masks</u> will be required.
- <u>Reduced classroom capacities</u> in the ESOP have been approved by University administration.
- All effort was made to maintain the current course schedules as much as possible.
- All effort was made to bring <u>each cohort of students to campus at least once per week</u> (PhD, PY1, PY2, PY3), though the entire cohort may not be on campus on the same day.
- Equity between in person and remote assessments will always be considered.

#### **Guidelines**

- Communication: Any updates to this plan will be communicated as follows:
  - Operational Return Committee > Education Enterprise Sub-Committee > Course Directors > Instructors, Students, and TAs
  - Weekly Fall course directors' meetings will provide regular updates from the Education Enterprise Sub-committee
- Social Distancing: required in all ESOP buildings.
  - Students, faculty, and staff must observe 6' of physical distancing in building spaces
  - There will be a 6' minimum distance between the instructor and the first row of students

- Certain clinical-based coursework will require less than 6' of social distancing, in which case the environment will mirror what is done in the clinical environment.
- Room capacities were reduced due to distancing requirements. (See list of classroom capacity on pages 12-13 of this document)
- Building Use: common use space (i.e. lunch space) will be identified that adheres to state and university guidelines
  - Student organizations should continue to reach out to Student Senate about using building space after hours. Note that all room capacities have been reduced (*see pages 12-13 of this document*).
  - Students are expected <u>not</u> to come to campus for class on days that they do not have an on campus class
- Hygiene: classrooms will be cleaned once per day.
  - Instructors are responsible for wiping down lecterns and equipment in the classrooms before and after teaching. Wipes will be provided by the School.
  - Students are responsible for wiping down desk and chair before and after class.
- Masks: required in accordance with UNC's <u>Community Standards</u>.
  - No masks required when teaching online alone from individual offices
- Online capability: Zoom connections will be operational for all courses based on the reality that individuals may require remote teaching and learning with the exception of the following course work (individualized considerations may be provided for students who are unable to complete on campus requirements).
  - <u>PharmD program</u>: the only identified PharmD didactic course components that cannot reasonably be completely in a remote environment are PHCY 513L-Pharm Compounding I-Nonsterile; PHCY 509: Immunization Training assessments (select assessment days); PHCY 601L: Patient Care Lab (select assessment days), PHCY 832: Innovations in Community Based Pharmacy Practice (elective) assessments (select assessment days)
  - <u>*PhD program:*</u> laboratory-based work where in person is required for completion (i.e., wet lab or clinical research)
  - <u>MS program</u>: teaching (faculty) and learning (students) for all courses can be delivered remotely; this program is already an approved remote/digital program hence online delivery will continue
- Assessments: Equity between in person and remote assessments will always be considered
  - An honor code statement is available via Exam Soft and is a requirement for every syllabus
  - In person assessment proctoring/monitoring will mimic as much as possible remote assessment proctoring/monitoring
  - Exam proctoring software are being evaluated and considered; at minimum for select remote assessments a zoom-based, dual device exam proctoring can be implemented (*this was piloted in the Spring 2020 semester*)
- Academic calendars:
  - <u>PharmD program:</u>
    - On campus learning will begin August 3, 2020 and be completed by November 24, 2020
    - Assessments after November 24, 2020 will be administered remotely
    - Fall Break will be maintained but with a focus to provide incentives for students to stay on campus/local

- <u>*PhD and MS programs:*</u> Graduate courses will begin on August 10, 2020 and follow the modified university calendar (final exams will conclude by November 24, 2020).
- Transportation: travel time to campus is a consideration due to reduced capacities.
  - Plan for increased travel time
  - Chapel Hill <u>transit</u>
- Changes: class schedules, classroom assignments, and meeting days and times cannot change once a plan is developed and distributed to course directors.
  - Faculty and instructors are expected to teach courses on the day and time indicated on the course schedule
  - Updated course schedules with room assignments are below in this document. (See course schedules on pages 5-11 of this document)

#### Proposed Plan:

MS program: all remote teaching and learning (as described above)

*PhD program:* all remote except for PHRS 801 to bring all 1<sup>st</sup> years to campus once per week.

- On Campus:
  - PHRS 801—Foundations for Cross-Disciplinary Training in Pharmaceutical Sciences.
  - Graduate students will also be on campus more frequently in laboratories as part of their research program requirements (PHRS 991 & PHRS 994).
- Online:
  - All other courses

#### PharmD program: (see weekly calendars below)

- PY1s (126 Chapel Hill students)—
  - On Campus:
    - Pharmacy Bridging Course
      - Day 1, Introduction to PBC and Pre-Assessments—all online
      - Other days (A & B days)—half of the cohort (63) will be on campus on A days, the other half will be on campus on B days.
    - Students will report to campus for all classes on the day of their 513L (Compounding Lab) section each week (*e.g.*,
      - Monday lab section students will attend all courses on campus on Mondays
      - Tuesday lab section students will attend all courses on campus on Tuesdays
      - Wednesday lab section students will attend all courses on campus on Wednesdays
      - Thursday lab section students will attend all courses on campus on Thursdays
      - Friday morning lab section students will attend all courses on campus on Wednesdays for class, and on Friday morning for lab.
      - Friday afternoon lab section students will attend all courses on campus on Thursdays for class, and on Friday afternoon for lab.

- Online:
  - Orientation
  - Days that students do not have 513L (Compounding Lab) (*e.g., Monday lab section students will attend courses online Tues, Thurs, Fri*)
  - Students who have the Friday afternoon Compounding Lab will attend PHCY 508— Pharmaceutical Calculations online.
- PY2s (135 Chapel Hill students, 23 Asheville)-
  - On Campus:
    - Tuesdays—half of the cohort will be on campus split between Kerr 1001 and 2001 (33/room) and Karpen 011 (12/room), 106 (6/room), and 110 (6/room). In Chapel Hill, "A" cohort will be on campus one week, and "B" cohort will be on campus the next week. <u>There will be no rotation in Asheville.</u>
    - Students enrolled in 601L (Patient Care Lab) as assigned on select dates throughout the semester (*estimated 2-3 dates*)
  - Online:
    - All other days and classes
    - Wednesdays when 601L (Patient Care Lab) does not meet in person
    - All assessment blocks
- PY3s (128 Chapel Hill students, 15 Asheville)—
  - On Campus:
    - Monday—Every week, the Block cohort (full Block = 64 in CH; 15 in AVL) will be on campus split between Kerr 1001 and 2001 (32/room) and Karpen 011 (12/room) and 106 (6/room).
    - Students with electives on Monday afternoons will attend that class on campus during their on campus week and online during their online week.
    - Students without electives on Monday will leave campus after their required course that day.
    - Students enrolled in PHCY 832: Innovations in Community Based Pharmacy Practice will be present on campus on a select day for the live skills assessment (see syllabus)

    - All other days and classes
